INTELLECTUAL OUTPUT 2 (IO2)

The consortium has conducted a survey (IO1) in each partner country, in order to identify the current digital needs of Senior Citizens. Taking into consideration the results from IO1 and the identification of the Adult Learning opportunities and the e-services, the consortium identified 5 Modules to be included in the Digital Competences Framework for Active Aging (IO2):

- Information and Data Literacy
- Communication and Collaboration
- Digital Content Creation
- Safety
- Problem Solving

THE DIGITAL COMPETENCE FRAMEWORK FOR ACTIVE AGING

The Digital Competences Framework for Active Aging has been designed with benchmarks and indicators against which seniors' skills will be evaluated. Within the Intellectual Output 2 Teaching Materials, so-called the DIGITAL TEACHING AND LEARNING DATA BANK - for disadvantaged Senior Citizens have been developed. The materials will be used as the basis for the digital up-skilling learning programme for seniors aiming to equip them with the basic digital skills, in order to be socially included and to re-entre employment and communicate across Europe using various options provided on PCs, tablets, and smartphones.

Within the Intellectual Output 2, the most important e-services that seniors need from the public and private sector (banks, councils, etc.) were also identified.

SENIORS GO DIGITAL E-LEARNING PLATFORM

An e-learning platform was designed and developed in the framework of the "Seniors Go Digital" project, in order to host the teaching material that was created in the framework of the project. The e-learning platform contains all five (5) e-learning courses in English as well as in all partnership languages (Greek, Italian, Swedish and Bulgarian), making a total of 25 available courses.



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For recognition, validation, and endorsement of the digital skills acquired by seniors, Open Badge System will be used. Upon studying the e-Books and successful completion of the Final-Assessment Quiz, users can earn a digital Badge for each module that proves their abilities.

The courses consist of an optional Self-Assessment Quiz, the e-Books where all the educational material is presented in the form of chapters and subchapters, incorporating text, images, videos, external links.

The e-learning platform provides chat rooms and forums for the participants in the same course in order to encourage communication between students.

OPEN BAGDE SYSTEM

Open Badges are created online through the use of an open-platform and can be shown on various personal pages, such as FB, Twitter, LinkedIn, etc. In addition, Adult Educators will be able to use this method for their own teaching for adult learners in order to motivate them to participate in LLL opportunities.

Open Badges standard describes a method for packaging information about accomplishments, embedding it into portable image files as a digital badge and establishing an infrastructure for badge validation.





SHORT STAFF JOINT TRAINING ACTIVITY

Between the 4th and 6th of December 2018, a Short Staff Joint Training Activity was organized in Nicosia, Cyprus. During the training, the consortium finalized the learning modules, and the eLearning Material to be uploaded on the platform (www.seniorsgodigital.iit.demokritos.gr) designed especially for the needs of the project. The developer of the platform presented its functionalities and use which will be required during the training to be organized for senior citizens.
