In 2006, Parliament and the European Council included "digital competence" among the eight essential competences for "active citizenship".

Currently, 125 million European citizens are over the age of 50 and must become "digital elders" as soon as possible. The aim of the "Senior go digital" project, funded by the European Community, is to contribute to the digital literacy process of the over-55s, with a focus on the use of new media in lifelong learning, promoting communication and information technology (ICT) in all spheres of life.

The project aims to raise awareness of the integration of adults into contemporary European society, as the acquisition of new knowledge reduces the risk of social exclusion and promotes intergenerational communication.

The project aims to create a sustainable lifelong learning programme for the adult population.

It aims to train the elderly population with the skills and resources needed to benefit from information and communication technologies (ICT) to renew traditional learning and teaching processes through introducing a digital platform.
